The Hanging Tower (“Torre Sospesa”) designed by Architect Marzorati in the late 80s represents a symbol of post-industrial building and a crucial project for Milanese architecture. The interior refurbishment was due to the change of intended use (from offices to hotel): the new “resident” is called B&B Hotels, one of Europe’s most important international chains, with more than 300 hotels located in France, Germany, Italy, Morocco, Poland, Portugal and Czech Republic.
